ELIGIBILITY- The championship is open to all male amateur golfers with a handicap of **10.0** or less. All entries are subject to approval or rejection by the tournament committee at any time before or after the start of play.

FORMAT- 36-holes, Modified-stableford scoring.

FIELD- The tournament field will be limited to the first **100** accepted applications.

DIVISIONS- Championship (5.0 & below) A Division (5.1 – 10.0).

ENTRY PROCEDURE-

- 1) All entries must be mailed to: Kegonsa Amateur, P.O. Box 65, Stoughton, WI 53589, and must arrive prior to 5:00 PM (CDT) on May 7, 2007.
- 2) Entry fee of \$120.00 must accompany each application. *(includes 36 holes with cart, lunch and tournament expenses.)*
- 3) Applicants will be notified of their acceptance by email before May 8, 2007.

WITHDRAWAL- If an accepted entrant withdraws before 5:00 PM (CDT), May 18, 2007, the entry fee will be refunded following the completion of the tournament. If an entrant withdraws after 5:00 PM (CDT) on May 18, 2007, **no refunds** will be given.

REGISTRATION- All players must register thirty minutes prior to their scheduled tee time. Registration will be located in the Lake Kegonsa Room.

AWARDS- The tournament champion will be awarded the championship trophy. Merchandise prizes will be awarded to the top 10 and ties in each division. **\$750.00 (1st Place) in each division based on number on entries (merchandise).**

STARTING TIMES- Pairings will be emailed to all accepted applicants by Monday, May 14th, 2007. Players may also call (715) 330-0220 to obtain their starting time after May 14th, 2007.

DRESS CODE- Shorts are allowed for the championship. Proper collared golf shirts are required during all portions of the championship.

FOOTWEAR- Shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of the condition: **Disqualification.**

RULES OF PLAY- USGA Rules; **The one (1) ball rule will be in effect** for tournament play.

PRACTICE ROUND- All accepted players must call the Stoughton Country Club Pro Shop (608) 873-8464, to schedule a practice round.

Walk-ons will not be accepted.
