DeLuca wins Porter Cup in sudden death



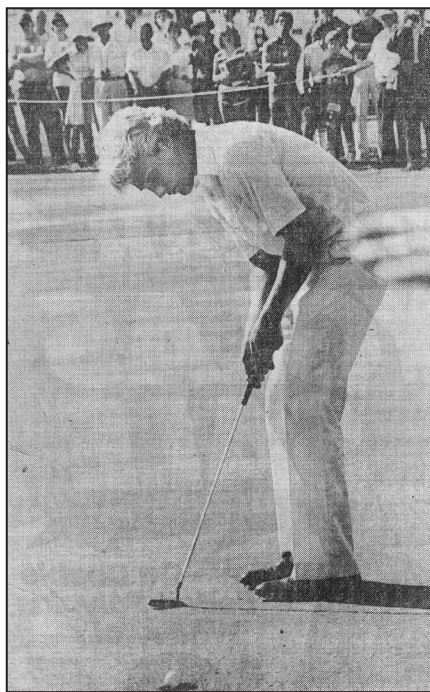
Tony DeLuca prevailed in the first Porter Cup playoff since Bill Harvey outlasted Charlie Smith in the 1963 tournament

Tony DeLuca just wanted to hit the green on the first sudden death playoff hole in the climax of the 22nd Annual Porter Cup. He did better than that, cracking a 7-iron approach to within 3 feet of the pin to set up a birdie putt which beat Jim Roy of Syracuse.

DeLuca, a 6-foot, 4-inch Virginian, seemed to be only a part of the supporting cast as Roy and veteran Jay Sigel were tied for the lead late in the tournament's final round. However, late bogies by the latter, coupled with a DeLuca birdie at the par-3, eighteenth set up the first Porter Cup playoff in 17 years.

Roy, a 21-year old junior at the University of South Florida, had a chance for victory on the last hole of regulation but his 12-foot birdie putt slide off to the right.

"This was my week," said the new Champion, a junior at the University of Florida. "I'm sure there are better players here than me, but this was my week."

CHIP SHOT... Bob Tway was named the PGA Tour Player of the Year in 1986 after recording four victories. He authored one of the most memorable shots in golf history at that year's PGA Championship, holing out a greenside bunker shot at the 18th hole on the final day to defeat hard-luck Greg Norman.
